The fully subsidised Pen CS software licensing includes:

- CAT4 a clinical audit tool that extracts data for practice analysis and targets key areas such as chronic disease management, data quality and accreditation, cancer screening, immunisation, eHealth and much, much more!
- **Topbar** a user friendly app to promote opportunistic care, helps improve data quality, chronic disease management and guidelines eHealth. It also provides recommended actions to meet MBS claim guidelines.
- PIP QI for General Practice A suite of tools and reports that will empower your
 practice to utilise date to drive quality improvement. Including PIP QI dashboard
 and featuring the identified QI PIP improvement measures which tracks and
 monitors QI for both practice and patients.
- Patient-Centred PIP QI Top Bar supports notification of the practitioner where there is missing information pertinent to improvement measures, matched to the presenting patient and opportunistic data cleansing.
- **Help Desk Support** Providing assistance to ensure effective use of PenCS software. Additional product training, step-by-step guides, webinars and help desk available via phone, email or fax 24 hours a day.
