Terms and Conditions

1. These terms and conditions relate to the following awards
 - **Cranes Trainee of the Year 2019**
 - **Cranes Training Company of the Year 2019**
 - **Cranes PTE of the Year 2019**
 - **Cranes Trainer of the Year 2019**
 - **Crane Leader of the Year 2019**
2. By submitting an application you accept and agree to these terms and conditions.
3. To enter the **Cranes Trainee of the Year Award 2019** you must currently be in a training agreement with The Skills Organisation ('Skills') in a New Zealand Certificate in Crane Operation (Level 3), New Zealand Certificate in Cranes (Dogman) (Level 3), New Zealand Certificate in Cranes (Advanced Crane Operation) (Level 4), New Zealand Certificate in Crane Supervision (Level 4), New Zealand Certificate in Cranes (Self-Erecting Tower Crane Erection) (Level 3), New Zealand Certificate in Cranes (Tower Crane Erection) (Level 4), New Zealand Certificate in Crane Operation (Piling and Foundation Operations) (Level 4) & New Zealand Certificate in Mobile Crane Dispatch Supervision (Level 3) OR you must have completed any of these qualifications within the period 1 May 2018 – 30 April 2019.
4. To enter the **Cranes Training Company of the Year Award 2019** you must have a trainee in a current training agreement with Skills in a New Zealand Certificate in Crane Operation (Level 3), New Zealand Certificate in Cranes (Dogman) (Level 3), New Zealand Certificate in Cranes (Advanced Crane Operation) (Level 4), New Zealand Certificate in Crane Supervision (Level 4), New Zealand Certificate in Cranes (Self-Erecting Tower Crane Erection) (Level 3), New Zealand Certificate in Cranes (Tower Crane Erection) (Level 4), New Zealand Certificate in Crane Operation (Piling and Foundation Operations) (Level 4) & New Zealand Certificate in Mobile Crane Dispatch Supervision (Level 3) OR you must have a trainee that completed any of these qualifications within 1 May 2018 – 30 April 2019. The award is restricted to one award for one trainee in 2019.
5. To enter the **Cranes Trainer of the Year Award 2019** you must be training a trainee in a current training agreement with Skills in a New Zealand Certificate in Crane Operation (Level 3), New Zealand Certificate in Cranes (Dogman) (Level 3), New Zealand Certificate in Cranes (Advanced Crane Operation) (Level 4), New Zealand Certificate in Crane Supervision (Level 4), New Zealand Certificate in Cranes (Self-Erecting Tower Crane Erection) (Level 3), New Zealand Certificate in Cranes (Tower Crane Erection) (Level 4), New Zealand Certificate in Crane Operation (Piling and Foundation Operations) (Level 4) & New Zealand Certificate in Mobile Crane Dispatch Supervision (Level 3) OR you must have trained a trainee that completed any of these qualifications within 1 May 2018 – 30 April 2019. You must also be a registered crane workplace assessor or contract assessor with Skills. The award is restricted to one award for one trainee in 2019.
6. To enter the **Cranes PTE Trainer of the Year Award 2019** you must be, through an accredited Private Training Establishment (PTE), be training a trainee in a current training agreement with Skills in a New Zealand Certificate in Crane Operation (Level 3), New Zealand Certificate in Cranes (Dogman) (Level 3), New Zealand Certificate in Cranes (Advanced Crane Operation) (Level 4), New Zealand Certificate in Crane Supervision (Level 4), New Zealand Certificate in Cranes (Self-Erecting Tower Crane Erection) (Level 3), New Zealand Certificate in Cranes (Tower Crane Erection) (Level 4), New Zealand Certificate in Crane Operation (Piling and Foundation Operations) (Level 4) & New Zealand Certificate in Mobile Crane Dispatch Supervision (Level 3) OR you must have trained a trainee that completed any of these qualifications within 1 May 2018 – 30 April 2019. You must also be a registered crane workplace assessor with an accredited Private Training Establishment. The award is restricted to one award for one trainee in 2019.

7. To enter the **Cranes Leader of the Year Award 2019** you must have been involved in the crane industry for a minimum of two years.
8. Entries can be made by the trainee, their employer, or a representative of their employer.
9. The closing date for applications is 19 May 2019. No entries will be accepted after 5pm on this date.
10. These awards are not open to employees or their families of Skills or any of Skills' subsidiaries ('Skills Group').
11. Crane Association of New Zealand (CANZ) has the right to deem an entrant or nomination ineligible to enter into the awards at their sole discretion.
12. You agree:
 - a. That the Skills Group may use any video or photography submitted by you as part of your application for this scholarship for marketing purposes and the promotion of its business activities, including but not limited to future award promotion campaigns, whether or not you are successful in your application and you waive any claims to royalty, rights or remuneration for such use; and
 - b. To the Skills Group accessing and sharing any information held by us about you and your training activities with the judging panel for these awards; and
 - c. To the judging panel contacting your local representative from Skills, your workplace assessor and your employer to confirm any details of your application; and
 - d. That, if your application is successful, you are happy to participate in any promotional and media activities organised by the Skills Group or CANZ.
13. You accept that:
 - a. Selection of the award winners is at the judges' discretion and the decision is final with no further correspondence entered into; and
 - b. If you are an award winner, you will receive the following:

 - **Cranes PTE of the Year 2019: A short Course with IMNZ up to the value of \$1500**
 - **Cranes Trainer of the Year 2019: A short Course with IMNZ up to the value of \$1500**
 - **Crane Leader of the year 2019: A short Course with IMNZ up to the value of \$1500**
